March 20, 2015

One of the many great membership benefits of the TADC is the active legislative program the Association maintains. Any proposed bill with implications to the civil justice system is monitored from filing until the end of session. Legislation will vary as to impact, ranging from local jurisdiction issues to statewide implications. Legislation of major import is analyzed and your officers and directors are prepared to testify before the appropriate committee on the appropriate bill at a moment's notice.

This Session, the TADC is monitoring over 300 bills. In an effort to keep every member informed as to where bills are in the process, and at the same time not inundating everyone with email every day, the TADC will send a progress report every Friday. This will be in addition to the regular monthly E-Update and any important legislative alerts.

The report each Friday will indicate any movement on TADC tracked bills for the week. Be advised, the caption of the bill may not adequately describe in enough detail what the bill actually does!

Each bill listed is linked so that you may see the proposed legislation in full.
