PLEASE NOTE: Calendar deadlines continue to trigger under the rules in both the House and the Senate. Today, May 15, 2015 is the LAST DAY the House may consider a consent House Bill on 2nd or 3rd reading and ALL House Bills on 3rd reading on the supplemental calendar.

On a related note, HB 1603 by Representative Villaba, creating a chancery court system in Texas, is stalled with no likelihood of movement this session as a result of calendar deadlines and the hard work and input of TADC and many other interested and affected groups with a mission preserve the civil justice system in Texas
