## LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

May 29, 2015

With less than four days left in the 84th Legislative Session, calendar deadlines continue to fall. Today, May 29, 2015 is the LAST DAY the House may act on Senate amendments. Tomorrow, May 30, 2015 is the last day conference committee reports may be distributed (a 24 hour lay-out is required). Sunday, May 31, 2015 is the last day conference committee reports may be adopted and Monday, June 1, 2015 is Sine die, the end of the Legislative Session.

Note that HB 1692 by Representative Sheets, relating to Forum Non Conveniens, was sent to the Governor this week and is awaiting his signature.

This will be the final weekly legislation "movement" update. Look for a TADC Legislative E-Update summary of Session action early next week.

Be advised, the caption of the bill may not adequately describe in enough detail what the bill actually does! Each bill listed is linked so that you may see the proposed legislation in full.
